

# The 5-Zone Appliance Installation Checklist

Run this before the crew drives away, from Max Appliance Repair Halifax

## Before delivery

- 1 Measure the opening and the full path in**  
Height, width, depth, plus every doorway, hallway, and turn.
- 2 Confirm the outlet, voltage, and breaker**  
Older HRM homes often have a plug that does not match a modern appliance.
- 3 Book a licensed gas technician if needed**  
Gas connections legally require a licensed pro in Nova Scotia.

## During install

- 1 Remove front-load washer shipping bolts**  
The single most forgotten step; the machine will shake without it.
- 2 Use new braided hoses and check the drain loop**  
Old hoses burst; a missing high loop lets dirty water back up.
- 3 Leave the recommended clearances**  
Fridges, ranges, and dryers all need air to shed heat.
- 4 Level the appliance and fit anti-tip brackets**  
Older floors are rarely flat; brackets are a real safety device.

## Before you finish

- 1 Run a test cycle and watch for leaks**  
Towel and flashlight underneath while connections are still visible.
- 2 Peel protective film and register the warranty**  
Two minutes now saves money and looks later. Photograph the data plate.
